California State Propositions

no position	Prop 14	Stem Cell Research, issues \$5.5 billion in bonds.
YES	Prop 15	Schools & Communities First, rolls back property tax windfall for commercial and industrial properties, split-roll modification of Prop 13 of 1996.
YES	Prop 16	Affirmative Action in public employment, education and contracting, repeals Prop 209 of 1996.
YES	Prop 17	Free the Vote , restores the right to vote to people convicted of felonies who are on parole.
YES	Prop 18	Youth Vote , allows 17-year-olds to vote in a Primary if they turn 18 by the next General Election.
no position	Prop 19	Property Tax Breaks and Wildfire Fund , changes tax assessment transfers and inheritance rules.
NO	Prop 20	Tough On Crime , increases penalties on violent and property crimes, limits parole.
YES	Prop 21	Rent Control , expands local governments' power to strengthen ordinances.
NO	Prop 22	Rideshare Drivers , Uber & Lyft-sponsored measure to exploit their employees as self-employed.
YES	Prop 23	Dialysis Clinics , requires physician on-site and consent from the state for a clinic to close.
no position	Prop 24	Consumer Privacy , expands provisions of state law and creates agency to implement and enforce.
YES	Prop 25	End Cash Bail , replaces bail with risk assessment for those awaiting trial, upholds SB 10 of 2018.
